

Application Look & Feel

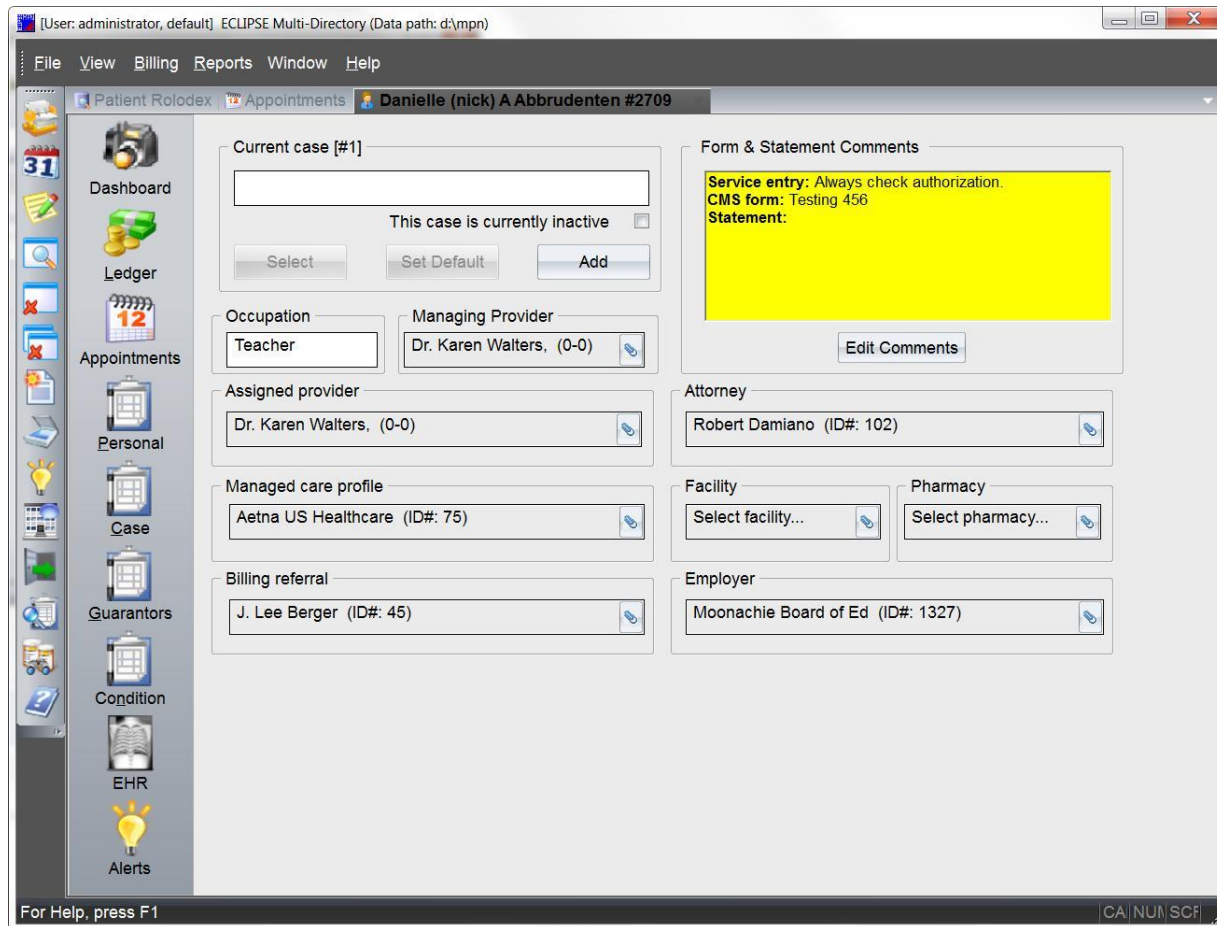
Please select **Application Look** from the ECLIPSE **Window** menu. Select an option (theme) that provides what you want. For example, the *Office 2000* theme on the **Microsoft Office** sub menu does not paint grid backgrounds. Note that after selecting a new theme, you must exit & re-launch the tab (e.g. appointments) for which you want to choose a new color scheme before it will take effect.

Next, you have additional control of these features via the ECLIPSE configuration.

- You can apply themes to **Ledger** grids by overriding your configured color settings: First, select **System** from the **File | Utilities | Configuration** menu. Then, select **Ignore colors. Use current ECLIPSE Application Look** from the Configuration's **Ledger** tab,
- The current Application Look will not be used within the scheduler unless it has been explicitly set in the Configuration's **Appointments** tab. Mark the checkbox to use the current theme: *Ignore colors in *unassigned* appointment cells. Use current Application Look.*
